Voluntary Contributions and Charges

We aim to make the structure of school contributions and charges clear for parents. Our efforts focus on keeping costs as low and equitable as possible, in accordance with the Education Act Regulations.

Voluntary Contributions (Kindergarten to Year 10)

The 2026 Voluntary Contributions and Charges sheets for each year level detail how voluntary contributions are allocated to learning areas from Kindergarten to Year 10. Please note that a decline in voluntary contributions may result in a lower standard of educational materials for your child/ren.

Compulsory Charges

As per the Education Act Regulations, all Year 11 and 12 courses incur a compulsory charge. Year 9 and 10 Elective Courses B also incur a compulsory charge.

Optional Activities and Charges

Information on the maximum costs for optional activities such as excursions, camps, etc., that students may participate in, is also included.

Payment Options

All students will be issued with a Voluntary Contributions and Charges account statement by the end of February 2026. All charges are fully payable by **end of Term 1, 2nd April 2026**.

Outstanding Account Statements

All current students with an outstanding account balance will receive an account statement at the start of each term.

Students with outstanding charges will receive an account statement monthly and will retain these charges on their account, carrying over into the new school year, until paid.

A Compassionate View

This school is only too aware that the payment of school contributions and charges can be a burden for some families. Payment plans are available to support parents experiencing difficulties. However, we do need to talk to you about this. Ignoring accounts and reminders is unhelpful to all parties. The school is also keen to assist parents in selecting options that they can afford.

Contribution & Charge Types

There are three parts to the financial requests:

1. Voluntary Contributions Kindy to Year 10:

The school is requesting a voluntary contribution of \$60.00 for primary students and \$235.00 for secondary, for each student towards the cost of materials, textbooks, services, and facilities used by students in the educational program. These contributions will make a significant influence on the quality of educational programs delivered. Additional compulsory charges outside the basic core program incur additional charges above this figure and can be requested for consumable and additional resources.

2. Charges:

a. **Year 7 - 10 Elective Courses** may attract a compulsory charge.

Years 11 & 12 is considered compulsory and therefore all charges are considered compulsory under the Education Act Regulations. As there is no maximum charge the school will try to keep costs to a minimum.

Any parents experiencing difficulties please contact the school to explore options.

b. **Other Optional School Based Activities – Kindergarten to Year 12** - address broad learning outcomes and for which there is a high cost. E.g., school social events, excursions, incursions, camps, carnivals etc. A maximum cost for these has been listed and parents only pay if their students take part. These costs will be collected throughout the year as the activities arise. These amounts can vary from year to year depending on visiting artists and specific learning area activities. These charges are the maximum possible costs to participate in these activities for the year. Payments are made prior to each event.

3. Additional Voluntary Approved Requests:

The following voluntary donations also appear on student Contributions and Charges sheets:

- **P & C Contribution** - Exmouth District High School P & C earnestly seek your continued support for 2026 by appealing to parents for a contribution of \$15.00 per family. Please consider becoming a member, and you are encouraged to attend meetings. Membership of the P & C Association is \$1.00 per family and payable at the meetings.
- **Library** - The library contribution of \$10.00 per family assists in the purchase and provision of resources for all students to use and borrow.



Education Program Allowance

The West Australian Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink or Veterans Affairs card that represents a statement of income for the family.

The allowance consists of two components:

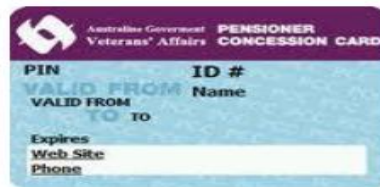
- ❖ \$115 Clothing allowance paid directly to the applicant or the school.
- ❖ \$235 Educational Program Allowance paid directly to the school.

Application is made by the parent or guardian for student/s enrolled in Years 7 - 12 at a Secondary School.

Eligibility Criteria

Parent or guardian must hold one of the following cards:

- ❖ Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
- ❖ Centrelink Family Health Care Card
- ❖ Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (blue card)



The parent/guardian must be the holder of a card that is valid sometime during first term. The only exception to this is when a student holds their own health care card and has been declared independent by Centrelink (e.g. living away from home). In this instance, a letter of confirmation from Centrelink needs to accompany the application.

The allowance is paid up to and including the year the student turns 18 years of age.

Application forms are to be completed at the school during Term 1, last date to accept is 2nd April 2026.

Late Applications

Late applications will only be accepted if the student has recently arrived from interstate or overseas and enrolled after the end of the first term.

Contributions and Charges

Schools will receive the Education Program Allowance of \$235 for Secondary Assistance recipients. This will be applied towards education program charges in the first instance, with any residual to be applied to the voluntary contribution (for years 7 to 10) or as negotiated with the parent/guardian (for years 11 to 12).

Clothing Allowance

The clothing allowance of \$115.00 will be paid to the parent/guardian unless indicated on the application form that you wish it to be paid to the school. If payment to the parent/guardian is requested, the payment will be deposited into the parent/guardian's bank account.



Further Information

Uniforms

The school uniform and uniform policy is supported by the School Board, EDHS staff, families, and wider community. There is an expectation that students will meet the uniform dress requirements. Uniforms are available for purchase online organised through the EDHS P & C Volunteers.
